

# Coordinated Care Tracking System (CCTS)



The Coordinated Care Tracking System (CCTS) is a robust and user-friendly clinical tool with a national presence and a web-based interface. CCTS ensures timely diagnosis, triage, and longitudinal follow-up for patients. It greatly enhances patients' safety by eliminating delays in diagnosis and treatment and ensuring timely access to care for cancer and complex medical conditions.



## CCTS is web based

- Interface designed by clinicians
- Promotes case management workflow
- Patient, station, and VISN level reporting for disease management, timeliness of care, and workload



## CCTS connects directly to EHR data

- Patient data available securely to clinicians VA-wide
- Daily updates keep patient data accurate



## CCTS ensures timely diagnosis and care

- Alert queue shows possible cancer indicators in imaging
- Task queue for upcoming, incomplete, or missed treatments
- Patient care synchronized across multiple stations

CCTS can generate a variety of reports to describe overall system performance for quality measurement, e.g., timeliness of care, number of cases read, etc.

Hosting CCTS at the national data center allows display of patients' care across multiple stations to provide truly integrative care and to develop regional care teams.
